Core to this is the implementation of efficiencies, waste reduction and reuse strategies.

AusPress is committed to achieve this by following the principles of:

- Having facility to separate materials with the express intention of recycling and reuse reuse and recycle at every opportunity.
- Consider the method of freight transport for both incoming and outgoing product and its
  effect on the environment.
- Consider packaging methods to reduce or eliminate unnecessary materials while maintaining the expectations of product quality and protection of the contents.
- Consolidating where possible for smaller and more efficient options.
- Encourage staff travel options beyond individual car transport.
- Understand the requirements and only order/consume what is the necessary.
- Chemicals to be used only when necessary, in suitable situation and disposed of as per the relevant Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
- Preference suppliers with environmental credentials and certification.
- Observe appropriate vehicle maintenance including washing, servicing and operation to protect the environment from chemical contamination, excessive dust, noise and impact.
- Review processes to reduce noise and light effecting adjacent residents and tenants where possible.
